



Tiny Watch Privacy Policy

Last updated: May 3, 2026

This Privacy Policy explains how Tiny Watch handles information when you use the Tiny Watch mobile application and the public website at <https://tinywatch.app>.

Tiny Watch is designed to be local-first: two phones connect over the same Wi-Fi network, without a Tiny Watch account and without Tiny Watch cloud streaming.

1. Quick Summary

- Tiny Watch does not require an account.
- Tiny Watch does not operate cloud video or cloud audio streaming for the app.
- The current app does not include third-party advertising or analytics SDKs.
- Live camera and microphone data is used to stream from the Camera Phone to the paired Monitor Phone over your local connection.
- Pairing and monitoring data is intended to stay between your devices on your local network, except for normal platform and network behavior outside our control.
- If you email us for support, we receive the information you choose to send.
- The public website may be served by hosting providers that process standard technical data needed to deliver the site and protect it.

2. Who We Are

3. Scope

This Policy covers Tiny Watch's own app and website practices. It does not cover your device operating system, app stores, routers, internet service providers, email providers, or other third-party services that may process information under their own policies.

4. Information Processed by the App

The app processes information needed to provide local baby monitoring features:

- Camera and microphone data, when you grant permission, so the Camera Phone can stream live video and audio to the paired Monitor Phone.
- Local network information such as local IP address, port, Wi-Fi/network status, and pairing details so the two phones can find and connect to each other.

- A short pairing secret used to help limit pairing to the intended Monitor Phone. In the current implementation, the pairing secret shown by the Camera Phone expires after a short period.
- Device status such as battery and charging state so the Monitor Phone can show Camera Phone status.
- Motion and audio alert signals generated from the local stream so the Monitor Phone can notify you about relevant changes.
- WebRTC connection state and related technical information needed to establish and maintain the local connection.

Tiny Watch does not use this information to create an account profile, run behavioral advertising, or operate cloud monitoring.

5. Camera, Microphone, and Child Information

Tiny Watch is intended for use by adults who choose to monitor a child or room using their own devices.

Video and audio may include a child's image, voice, room, surroundings, or other personal information visible or audible to the Camera Phone. Tiny Watch uses that information to provide the live local monitoring feature. Tiny Watch does not intentionally collect, store, or transmit that live stream to Tiny Watch servers.

The app does not intentionally record the stream or provide cloud storage. Your device, operating system, or other apps may offer separate features such as screenshots or screen recording, which are outside Tiny Watch's control.

6. Website and Support Information

If you visit <https://tinywatch.app>, hosting providers may process standard technical information such as IP address, user agent, requested URL, timestamps, and diagnostic logs as needed to deliver, secure, and maintain the website.

The current public website does not use advertising cookies or third-party analytics scripts.

If you contact us by email, we process your email address, message content, attachments, and related metadata so we can respond, troubleshoot, maintain records, and protect our rights.

7. App Store and Platform Information

If you download Tiny Watch through Apple App Store, Google Play, or another app store, that store may process information such as your account, device, purchase, installation, crash, or usage data under its own privacy policy.

Operating systems may also process permission, diagnostic, notification, network, and crash information. Tiny Watch does not control those platform practices.

8. How We Use Information

We use information only for purposes reasonably related to Tiny Watch:

- Providing local video, audio, pairing, status, and alert features.
- Troubleshooting bugs and responding to support requests.
- Maintaining, securing, and improving the app and website.

- Complying with legal obligations and enforcing our terms.

9. Legal Bases for EEA and UK Users

Where data protection law requires a legal basis, we rely on one or more of the following:

- Contract, when processing is needed to provide Tiny Watch features you request.
- Consent, when you grant device permissions or choose to contact us.
- Legitimate interests, such as maintaining security, preventing abuse, responding to support, and improving reliability.
- Legal obligations, when we must retain or disclose information to comply with law.

10. Sharing

We do not sell personal information. We do not share app live video or audio with advertisers.

We may share limited information with service providers that help us operate the website, email, support, hosting, security, or distribution, but only for those service purposes. App stores and device platforms may process information independently under their own policies.

We may also disclose information if required by law, to protect rights and safety, or in connection with a business transfer such as a merger, acquisition, or asset sale.

11. Retention

Tiny Watch does not maintain Tiny Watch accounts and does not intentionally store app live video or audio on Tiny Watch servers.

Local app data remains on your devices until you delete it, uninstall the app, reset app data, or your operating system removes it. Support emails may be retained for as long as reasonably needed to respond, maintain records, resolve disputes, improve support, and comply with legal obligations. Website logs may be retained by hosting providers for operational and security purposes according to their settings and policies.

12. Your Choices and Rights

You can control app permissions through your device settings. If you revoke camera, microphone, or local network permissions, some Tiny Watch features may stop working.

You can stop a monitoring session, close the app, uninstall the app, or delete local app data through your device settings.

Depending on where you live, you may have rights to request access, correction, deletion, portability, restriction, objection, or withdrawal of consent for personal data we control. Because Tiny Watch does not require accounts and does not intentionally collect app stream data on Tiny Watch servers, we may have limited or no account data to provide. 13. Children

Tiny Watch is intended to be set up and used by adults, not by children. We do not knowingly collect account information from children.

Because the app is used for monitoring, the local live stream may include a child. That stream is controlled by the adult user on their own devices and is not intentionally collected or stored by Tiny Watch servers.

If you believe a child has sent us personal information directly, contact hello@tinywatch.app and we will take appropriate steps.

14. International Processing

If you contact us or visit the website, information may be processed in countries other than where you live. Where required, we use appropriate safeguards for international transfers.

15. Security

Tiny Watch is designed to reduce unnecessary cloud exposure by using local same-Wi-Fi monitoring. No system is perfectly secure. You should use trusted Wi-Fi networks, keep your devices and operating systems updated, protect access to pairing codes, and avoid showing pairing codes to people you do not want to connect.
