



# TinyWatch Terms and Conditions

Last updated: May 6, 2026

## 1. Who We Are

These Terms and Conditions ("Terms") apply to TinyWatch, a mobile application and related website/service that lets an adult use one phone as a local camera device and view the live stream from another device on the same Wi-Fi or local network.

In these Terms, "TinyWatch", "we", "us" and "our" mean the provider above. "You" means the adult who downloads, installs, accesses or uses TinyWatch.

## 2. Acceptance Of These Terms

By downloading, installing, accessing or using TinyWatch, you agree to these Terms. If you do not agree, do not use TinyWatch.

TinyWatch is intended to be set up and managed by parents, guardians or other responsible adults. Children should not set up, configure or operate TinyWatch without a parent or guardian.

If a child uses a device where TinyWatch is installed, the parent or guardian remains responsible for that use, including device access, monitoring setup, permissions, pairing links and safe placement of any phones, chargers or accessories.

If you use TinyWatch on behalf of a household, family, organisation or another person, you confirm that you have authority to do so and that you are responsible for that use.

### 3. What TinyWatch Does

TinyWatch lets an adult use a compatible phone as a Camera Phone and view the live camera feed from another compatible monitor device on the same Wi-Fi or local network. The monitor device may be another phone, a browser on a phone, a computer browser or another supported same-network screen, depending on the version and supported features available at the time.

For the browser-monitor flow currently promoted for TinyWatch, the TinyWatch app is needed on the Camera Phone. The monitor can open the QR link in a same-Wi-Fi browser, or use the TinyWatch app where supported.

TinyWatch is designed for short-term, local, same-network monitoring in ordinary household situations, for example when an adult is nearby and wants to check a child in another room.

TinyWatch does not use TinyWatch cloud video storage and does not use TinyWatch cloud video streaming for the Camera Phone video feed. This does not mean every TinyWatch-related service is cloud-free; for example, the website, app stores, support email, diagnostics or other non-video services may still use third-party infrastructure as described in the Privacy Policy.

The current TinyWatch app does not require a TinyWatch account or sign-in. It is not a chat, public sharing, creator or user-generated-content service.

TinyWatch is not designed for remote internet monitoring, medical monitoring, emergency monitoring, security monitoring or unattended child supervision.

### 4. Current Free Version And Future Paid Access

TinyWatch is currently provided as a free version. No paid subscription, paid plan or in-app purchase is currently active.

Free access is provided for evaluation, testing, launch validation and product development. Free access does not create a permanent right to use TinyWatch for free, does not guarantee continued availability of any feature, and does not prevent TinyWatch from becoming partly or fully paid in the future.

We may later introduce paid features, paid plans, subscriptions, one-time purchases, lifetime access, trials, promotional offers, usage limits, feature limits, paywalls or other charges. If paid access is introduced, the price, billing period, renewal terms, cancellation terms, refund rules and included features will be shown before purchase, and these Terms may be updated.

Existing free users may be asked to pay to continue using some or all TinyWatch features in the future. If you do not agree to a future paid plan or updated Terms, you should stop using TinyWatch.

Your app store, device manufacturer, mobile operator, internet provider or payment provider may have separate terms that apply to downloads, devices, networks or payments.

## 5. Paid Access, Subscriptions And Lifetime Access

This section applies only if TinyWatch later introduces paid access. It does not mean that paid access is currently available.

If subscriptions are introduced, they may renew automatically unless cancelled through the relevant app store, payment provider or account-management flow before renewal.

Subscription billing, renewal, cancellation, refund and trial rules may be controlled partly or fully by Apple, Google or another payment provider.

If one-time purchases are introduced, they provide only the paid entitlement described at purchase. A one-time purchase does not give you ownership of TinyWatch, its software, its intellectual property or any right to receive every future feature.

If "lifetime access" or similar wording is offered, it means access to the paid TinyWatch features described at purchase for as long as TinyWatch remains commercially and technically available, subject to these Terms, app store rules, platform availability, security, legal requirements and mandatory consumer rights. It does not mean access for your lifetime, a guaranteed minimum number of years, or a promise that TinyWatch will be maintained forever.

Prices, plans, features and availability may change over time. Any changes to active paid access will be handled according to the purchase terms shown at the time of purchase, applicable app store or payment-provider rules, and mandatory consumer law.

## 6. Adult Responsibility And Child Safety

TinyWatch is a convenience tool only. It is not a medical device, life-safety device, emergency service, security system, professional childcare service or substitute for direct adult supervision.

You remain fully responsible for the safety, supervision and wellbeing of any child or other person being monitored.

TinyWatch does not detect, prevent, diagnose or respond to:

- breathing problems, choking, suffocation or unsafe sleep;
- illness, injury, fever or other medical issues;
- falls, entrapment, strangulation or unsafe room conditions;
- fire, smoke, carbon monoxide, overheating, flooding or other environmental hazards;
- abduction, unauthorised entry, violence or other security incidents;
- any situation requiring emergency assistance.

Do not rely on TinyWatch where continuous supervision, medical monitoring, emergency response, security protection or life-safety reliability is needed. If you believe a child or any person may be in danger, check physically and contact emergency services where appropriate.

Audio, video, motion notices, sound notices, connection status and other alerts may fail, be delayed, be inaccurate, be muted, be missed, disconnect or stop working. You must

continue to make direct physical checks and use your own judgement.

## 7. Safe Placement Of Phones, Chargers And Accessories

TinyWatch uses phones, chargers, cables, stands, mounts and accessories owned or chosen by you. We do not provide, inspect, control or certify those devices or accessories.

You are responsible for safe setup and use. You must:

- keep phones, chargers, power banks, cables, mounts, tripods, stands and accessories out of cribs, bassinets, beds, playpens, sleeping areas and anywhere a child can reach;
- prevent strangulation, choking, entanglement, impact, fall, fire, electrical, overheating, battery and liquid exposure risks;
- use only devices, chargers, cables, mounts and accessories in good condition and according to the manufacturer's instructions;
- keep devices properly ventilated and away from bedding, pillows, blankets, curtains and flammable materials;
- monitor device temperature, battery level and charging state;
- stop using TinyWatch if a device becomes hot, damaged, unstable, wet, physically unsafe or unreliable.

You accept that phone hardware, battery health, charging behaviour, operating systems, routers, Wi-Fi equipment, browsers, permissions, sleep settings and accessories are outside our control. We are not responsible for damage, injury, loss or malfunction caused by your device, charger, cable, mount, accessory, network or unsafe placement.

## 8. Technical Requirements And Limitations

TinyWatch depends on compatible devices, operating systems, browsers, camera and microphone permissions, local network permissions, Wi-Fi quality, router configuration, battery level and other technical factors.

The current app should not require unrelated system-setting changes or device restarts, but you must still grant required permissions, keep devices on the same Wi-Fi/local network, and follow normal device and platform requirements.

TinyWatch may not work, or may work poorly, if:

- devices are not on the same Wi-Fi or local network;
- a router, firewall, VPN, guest network, parental control setting or network isolation blocks local connections;
- camera, microphone, local network or notification permissions are denied;
- the Camera Phone locks, sleeps, overheats, loses battery, loses network access or closes the app;
- the monitor browser or device is incompatible, asleep, muted or disconnected;
- the operating system restricts background camera, microphone, network or notification behaviour;

- the local network is congested, unstable or too weak.

We do not guarantee that TinyWatch will be uninterrupted, error-free, secure, compatible with every device, or available at any particular time.

## 9. Privacy, Consent And Lawful Monitoring

You must use TinyWatch only where you have the legal right to do so. You are responsible for complying with all privacy, recording, surveillance, childcare, workplace, tenancy, household, consent and notification laws that apply to your use.

You must not use TinyWatch to secretly, unlawfully or unfairly monitor another person. This includes adults, visitors, babysitters, caregivers, cleaners, workers, tenants, family members or children where monitoring would be unlawful or inappropriate.

Where required by law or context, you must tell people that monitoring is active and obtain any required consent before using TinyWatch.

You are responsible for the environment captured by the Camera Phone, including private, sensitive or personal information visible or audible in the room.

## 10. Pairing Codes, Links And Local Access

TinyWatch may use QR codes, pairing links, local connection details, local network addresses and short pairing secrets to connect a Camera Phone and monitor device.

You are responsible for protecting pairing codes and monitor links. Do not share them with anyone who should not view the camera feed. Stop a session if a pairing code or monitor link may have been seen, copied or used by someone else.

Anyone with access to your unlocked monitor device, browser session, pairing code or monitor link may be able to view or attempt to access the stream during an active session.

## 11. Acceptable Use

You must not:

- use TinyWatch unlawfully, abusively, deceptively or invasively;
- use TinyWatch for stalking, harassment, spying, workplace surveillance, tenant surveillance or hidden monitoring;
- monitor anyone where you do not have the required legal right or consent;
- use TinyWatch as a medical device, emergency service, security system or substitute for direct adult supervision;
- attempt to bypass security, access another user's stream, interfere with the service or reverse engineer the app except where applicable law allows;
- misuse pairing links, QR codes, local network details or any technical feature;
- use TinyWatch in a way that could damage devices, networks, people, property or our reputation.

We may suspend, restrict or stop providing TinyWatch if we reasonably believe the app is being misused or if needed for safety, legal, security or technical reasons.

## 12. App Stores, Platforms And Third Parties

TinyWatch may be downloaded through Apple App Store, Google Play or another distribution platform. Your use of those platforms is governed by their separate terms.

Apple, Google, device manufacturers, browser providers, operating system providers, internet providers and network equipment providers are not responsible for TinyWatch unless their own terms say otherwise.

TinyWatch may depend on third-party platform features, such as app stores, operating systems, browsers, device permissions, camera APIs, microphone APIs, local network APIs and notification systems. Those third-party features may change, fail or become unavailable.

## 13. Updates, Changes, Discontinuation And End Of Support

We may update, modify, suspend or discontinue TinyWatch or any feature at any time, including during the current free version.

Updates may be needed for security, compatibility, legal compliance, performance, product improvement or platform requirements. Some updates may change or remove features.

Core app behavior changes should be delivered through normal app store or platform update mechanisms. The current app is not designed to download, install or execute code that changes core app behavior after app review.

We may stop developing, supporting, distributing, maintaining or operating TinyWatch, or any part of it, for legal, security, technical, platform, commercial, business or operational reasons. This may include removing the app from an app store, stopping website or monitor-page access, ending support, disabling a feature, or making TinyWatch unavailable on some devices, operating systems, browsers, regions or networks.

We do not promise that TinyWatch, any free version, any paid feature, any monitor page, any support channel or any compatibility with a particular device, browser, operating system, app store or network will continue indefinitely.

If paid access is introduced later and TinyWatch or a paid feature is discontinued, your rights will depend on the purchase terms shown at the time of purchase, applicable app store or payment-provider rules, and mandatory consumer law.

## 14. Intellectual Property

TinyWatch, including the app, website, text, design, logos, software, code, trademarks and other materials, belongs to us or our licensors.

We grant you a limited, personal, revocable, non-exclusive, non-transferable licence to use TinyWatch for lawful personal household use in accordance with these Terms and applicable app store terms.

You do not acquire ownership of TinyWatch or any intellectual property rights in it.

## 15. Transfer Of TinyWatch

We may sell, transfer, assign or reorganise TinyWatch, the app, website, technology, intellectual property, contracts, user relationships, rights, obligations, business assets or related operations to a buyer, successor, affiliate or other entity.

If this happens, the buyer or successor may continue to provide TinyWatch under these Terms or updated terms, and may receive information needed to operate TinyWatch, support users, maintain purchase entitlements, comply with law and complete the transaction, as described in the Privacy Policy.

We will take reasonable steps to notify users where required by law. Nothing in this section limits mandatory consumer rights or privacy rights that cannot legally be waived.

## 16. Feedback

If you send us feedback, ideas, bug reports or suggestions, you allow us to use them without restriction or payment to you, unless we separately agree otherwise in writing.

Do not send confidential information in feedback unless we have agreed to receive it.

## 17. Privacy Policy

Our Privacy Policy explains how TinyWatch handles personal information. You should read it together with these Terms.

TinyWatch does not use TinyWatch cloud video storage and does not use TinyWatch cloud video streaming. If a feature or integration changes how data is processed, we will update the Privacy Policy where required.

The current TinyWatch app does not use a third-party advertising SDK, does not require a TinyWatch account or sign-in, and is not a chat, public sharing, creator or user-generated-content service. It also does not currently provide health research, VPN, MDM, gambling, contests, sweepstakes, regulated medical or location-service features. If any of those features are added later, the legal and privacy documentation should be reviewed before release.

## 18. No Warranties

To the maximum extent allowed by law, TinyWatch is provided "as is" and "as available".

We do not promise that TinyWatch:

- will keep any child or person safe;
- will detect hazards, emergencies, medical issues or security events;
- will provide uninterrupted, real-time or accurate audio, video or alerts;
- will work with every device, browser, router, Wi-Fi network, operating system or permission setting;
- will be free from bugs, delays, disconnections, security issues or data loss;

- will remain available, supported, maintained, free or compatible with future devices, browsers, app stores, operating systems or networks.

Nothing in these Terms excludes, restricts or modifies any consumer guarantee, statutory warranty, liability or right that cannot legally be excluded, restricted or modified, including mandatory rights under EU/Polish consumer law, applicable US state law or the Australian Consumer Law.

## 19. Limitation Of Liability

To the maximum extent allowed by law, we are not liable for indirect, incidental, special, consequential, exemplary or punitive damages, loss of profit, loss of data, loss of goodwill, device damage, network costs, missed alerts, failed monitoring, service interruption, loss of access, feature removal, end of support or discontinuation resulting from your use of or inability to use TinyWatch.

To the maximum extent allowed by law, we are not liable for injury, harm, property damage or loss caused by:

- reliance on TinyWatch instead of direct adult supervision or emergency response;
- unsafe placement or use of phones, chargers, cables, mounts, stands or accessories;
- phone battery, charging, overheating, electrical, liquid, hardware or operating system issues;
- router, Wi-Fi, network, browser, permission, device compatibility or platform problems;
- unlawful, secret, abusive or inappropriate monitoring by you or another person;
- inaccurate, delayed, missed or failed audio, video, motion, sound, connection or battery notices.

Where liability cannot legally be excluded, our liability is limited to the minimum amount permitted by applicable law.

Some jurisdictions do not allow certain exclusions or limitations. In those jurisdictions, the exclusions and limitations apply only to the extent permitted by law.

## 20. Your Responsibility For Claims

You are responsible for your use of TinyWatch and for any use by people who access TinyWatch through your devices, pairing links, QR codes, local network or monitor sessions.

To the maximum extent allowed by law, you agree to compensate us for losses, costs, damages, claims and expenses arising from your unlawful use, unsafe use, breach of these Terms, breach of another person's rights, or misuse of TinyWatch.

This section does not limit any mandatory consumer rights that cannot be waived under applicable law.

## 21. Termination

You may stop using TinyWatch at any time by ending active sessions, deleting the app and stopping access to the website or monitor page.

We may suspend or terminate access to TinyWatch if needed for safety, legal, security, platform, product or technical reasons, or if you breach these Terms.

Sections that by their nature should survive termination will continue to apply, including safety responsibility, lawful use, intellectual property, disclaimers, limitation of liability and governing law.

## **22. Governing Law And Disputes**

These Terms are governed by the laws of Poland, except where mandatory consumer protection laws in your country require otherwise.

If you are a consumer in the European Union, United Kingdom, United States, Australia or another jurisdiction, you may have mandatory local rights that continue to apply regardless of this governing law clause.

Disputes will be handled by the competent courts or authorities under applicable law. Nothing in this section limits any mandatory consumer rights or dispute-resolution rights that apply in your country.

## **23. Changes To These Terms**

We may update these Terms from time to time. If changes are material, we will take reasonable steps to notify users, for example through the app, website or app store listing.

The updated Terms apply from the date shown at the top or from another date stated in the notice. If you do not agree to updated Terms, stop using TinyWatch.

If we introduce paid access or materially change paid access, we will show the material purchase terms before purchase where required. If we materially change how personal information is processed, we will update the Privacy Policy and provide notice or obtain consent where required by law.
